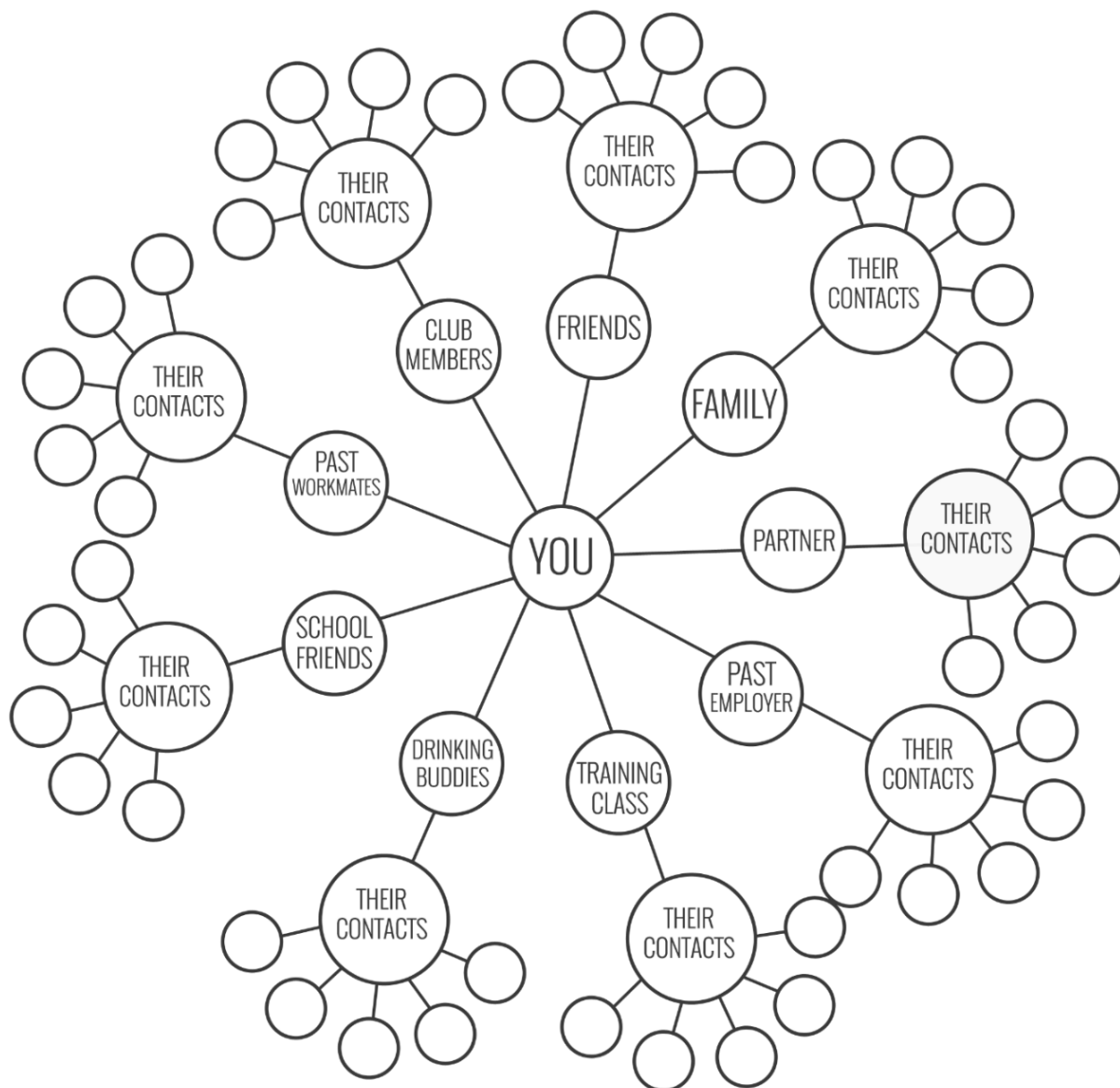


Your Personal Network – Example
